

SIMATIC PCS 7 Service 1 (ST-PCS7SR1)

Short Description

In this face-to-face course you will learn how to handle a process control system as a technical service personnel, and their main focus on the care, maintenance, and repair of existing systems with SIMATIC PCS 7. The focus is on the tasks of a maintenance technician, such as the replacement of individual components, as well as the handling and compilation of diagnostic data from the various system areas of a process control system.

Through practical exercises in a training environment, where you work as in reality in operational situations, you will immediately put your newly acquired theoretical knowledge into practice and deepen it.

After attending the course, you will be able to quickly obtain comprehensive diagnostic data from a running SIMATIC PCS 7 system and carry out simple maintenance work without STOP the system. This enables a reduction in downtimes and increases the efficiency of your automation system.

- operate the Simatic Manager and work with a multi-project environment.
- navigation in the visualization environment on the operator station.

- network analysis of terminal-, plant- and fieldbus (Profibus and PROFINET).
- perform on-site fault analysis on the device and carry out the corresponding troubleshooting.
