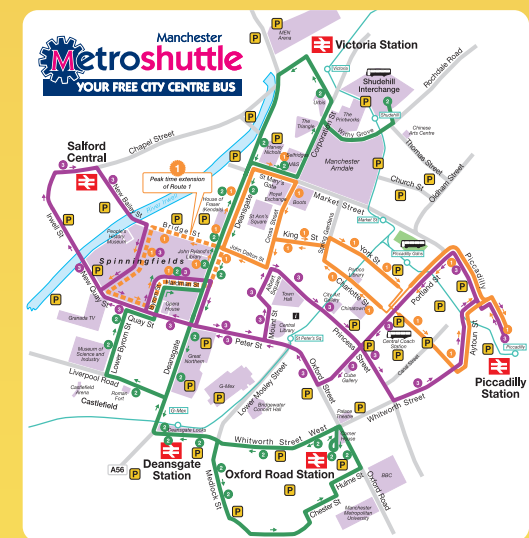


City centre

Welcome! Manchester's compact city centre contains lots to do in a small space. To help, we've colour coded the city. Explore and enjoy!

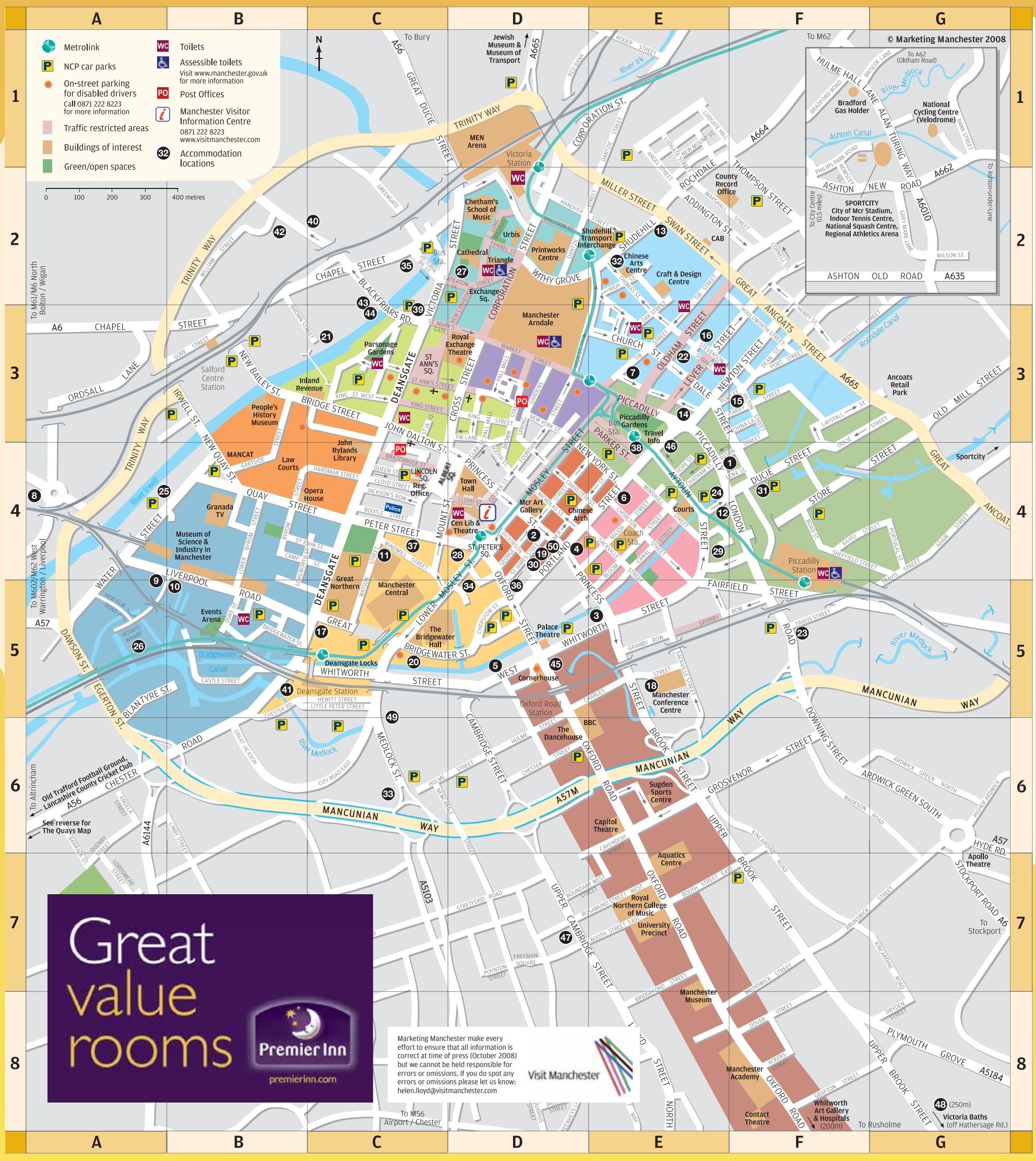
- Manchester Arndale & Market Street**
